Common Questions

1. Does it even matter what I believe?
The right kind of faith in the right person does matter.
2. Aren't all religions basically the same?
Christianity is unlike any other religion in the world.
3. How can anyone say what's right and wrong?
God and His Word is the standard to judge what is right and wrong.
4. How can Christians believe in God when evolution is a proven fact?
Science is ever changing. The Bible speaks of super-natural intervention.
5. If God exists, why is there so much wrong with this world?
God does not make evil happen. God allows humans to choose. Belief in evil presupposes God's existence. We do not know all of God's reason for allowing some things.
6. Why be a Christian when there are so many hypocrites in churches?
People aren't perfect – inside a church or outside. God doesn't want self-righteous people but those who seek His forgiveness.
7. If God loves everyone, how can He send some people to hell?
No one is good enough to earn eternal life and avoid hell. Jesus made it possible for anyone to be forgiven.
