Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

Psalms 19:7 The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; **8** the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; **9** the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether. **10** More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. **11** Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward. ... **14** Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.

Psalms 119:11 I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. **12** Blessed are you, O LORD; teach me your statutes! **13** With my lips I declare all the rules of your mouth. In the way of your testimonies I delight as much as in all riches. **15** I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways. ... **24** Your testimonies are my delight; they are my counselors. ... **27** Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous works. ... **97** Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day.
