## SUFFERING AS A CHRISTIAN 1<sup>ST</sup> PETER 5

The book of 1st Peter is a textbook on "Suffering because you are living as a Christian."

The closing summary on suffering for Christ:

- 5:10 And after you have **suffered** for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.
- 5:12b I have written to you briefly, exhorting/encouraging you and testifying that this/*suffering* is the true grace of God. Stand firm in it!

Three irrefutable truths to rely of as you are living through your current episode of suffering.

- 1. God is in control! 2. God loves you! 3. God will get you through it! 1st Peter 1:3-9
- 1. Encouragement to the Suffering Elders vs 1-4
  - 1 I exhort the elders among you, as your fellow elder ...
  - 2 Shepherd the flock; exercise oversight voluntarily; according to God's will; with eagerness
  - 3 not lording it over those allotted to your charge, but as examples to the flock

Crown of Glory - <u>for Elders</u> who protect and disciple the saints in their care v4 (Other Crowns described in Scripture:

Crown of Rejoicing – for Saints who evangelize 1st Thess 2:19,20

Crown of Righteousness – <u>for Saints</u> who fulfill their ministry & love His appearing 2<sup>nd</sup> Tim 4:7.8

Crown of Life – for Saints who endure James 1:12 Rev 2:10)

2. Encouragement to the Suffering Younger Men v 5a

Be subject to the elders; they are more mature than you and they desire God's best for you.

- 3. Encouragement & Advice to All Sufferers vs 5b-11
  - 6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, 7 casting all your anxiety upon Him, because He cares for you.
  - 8 Be of a sober spirit, be on the alert ... 9 resist the devil, firm in your faith; know others suffer.
  - 10 And after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace will Himself:

**Perfect** – Successful Suffering matures us spiritually; we learn God's faithfulness

**Confirm** – Successful Suffering makes us more convinced; more confident, less worried

Strengthen – Successful Suffering strengthens/exercises our will/courage

Establish/Settle – Successful Suffering firms up our foundation
