Matt 6:25 Jesus taught: "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? 26 Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? 27 And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? 28 And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, 29 yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. 30 But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? 31 Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' ... 32b your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. 33 But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."

Heroes of the Faith Hebrews 11

- 1. **Seek the Invisible** v1 Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
- 2. **Seek the Imperishable** v10 <u>looking forward to the city (the New Jerusalem)</u> which has foundations, whose designer and builder is God. v16 they desire a better country, that is, a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God; for He has prepared for them a city.
- 3. **See the Impossible Accomplished by God!** v24 <u>By faith</u> Moses, when he was grown up, <u>refused</u> to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, 25 <u>choosing</u> rather to be mistreated with the people of God than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. 26 He <u>considered</u> the reproach of Christ greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, for he was <u>looking to the reward</u>. 27 <u>By faith</u> he left Egypt, not being afraid of the anger of the king, for he endured as <u>seeing Him who is invisible</u>.
