ORDIANCES OF THE CHURCH

Baptism

- 1. Baptism is an act of obedience to Christ's command. (Matthew 28:19-20)
- 2. Baptism is a public declaration of your faith in Christ. (Acts 8:12)
- 3. Baptism is identification with Christ & other Christians. (Acts 18:8)
- 4. Baptism is a symbol of Christ's death, burial, & resurrection. (Romans 6:4-5; Acts 8:38-39)

The Lord's Supper

The Lord Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper so that we would always remember that which we should never forget – His death, burial, resurrection, and His coming again. The bread represents Christ's body given for us. The cup represents His blood shed for us. (Matthew 26:17-30; 1 Corinthians 11:23-30; 10:16-17)

In the Lord's Supper, we:

- 1. Look Back at Jesus' death.
- 2. Look Up at a Risen, Living Lord.
- 3. Look Inward and confess any sin.
- 4. Look Outward in fellowship with other Christians.
- 5. Look Forward to Jesus Coming Again.
